The Wet'suwet'en are deeply connected to their ancestral lands and waters, which are threatened by the pipeline. Their Hereditary Chiefs (on behalf of their clans) did not consent to its construction.

I demand the Government of British Columbia stop the criminalization and harassment of Wet'suwet'en land defenders and their allies.
